- Performing a daily safety/housekeeping audits of the warehouse.
- Communicating and coordinating with other departments. Liaison between Agencies, Volunteer Service and 1095 warehouse.
- Support Dispatch to ship and receive product.
- Move product around warehouse, operating warehouse equipment safely and efficiently (equipment that may be utilized includes forklifts, pallet jacks, pallet wrapper, etc.)
- Oversee Freezer and Fridge optimization (FIFO)
- Hands-on commitment to getting the job done.
