Harvest Manitoba (“Harvest”) is a charitable organization dedicated to nourishing our communities and our sense of community so that no Manitoban goes hungry. We receive 11 million pounds of food every year, which is sorted and packed largely by volunteers into Harvest Hampers and distributed to Manitobans through our Community Food Network of more than 325 food banks and agencies in Winnipeg, rural, northern and First Nations communities. Right now, we feed 80,000 Manitobans every month, 46% children. Our Food Distribution Centre, which includes our Emergency Food Support Assistance Line and Warehouse, is in our Winnipeg Headquarters.

We are seeking a dedicated **Fleet and Equipment Maintenance Coordinator** who will work well with our team and ensure that fleet and equipment is available, dependable, and safe always. This person must have exceptional organizational and time management skills and should be experienced with mechanical and equipment maintenance.

Reports to: Senior Facilities Manager

Responsibilities:

- Analyze maintenance costs and provide recommendations on fleet utilization and replacement through Samsara system and day-to-day monitoring.
- Track fleet usage and maintain accurate inventory of equipment, including fluids, first aid kits and check lists.
- Ensure fleet maintenance records are accurate and up to date. Establish schedules and methods for providing fleet maintenance and repair services in a timely fashion and within budget.
- Prepare regular weekly and monthly maintenance report and parts usage for management appraisal as required.
- Communicate maintenance requirements to ensure maximum efficiency and implement corrective actions as required.
- Identify maintenance employee training requirements and ensure successful completion.
- Coach drivers on identification of faults and ways of reporting or providing continuous, constructive feedback regarding performance of assets in transit.
- Investigate incidents and accidents, report them to the Senior Warehouse Manager, and complete all required paperwork.
- Coordinate outside fleet repairs; may include identifying and placing orders for repair/replacement parts for vehicles and equipment.
- Move, charge, start, and assess fleet equipment in the yard from time to time, regardless of what season it is.
- Perform other duties as assigned around the facility.
- As a member of the Harvest Manitoba CREW, support the team however needed to ensure operational needs are being met.
